Due to the circumstances, camp will <u>NOT</u> be available on a drop in bases and must sign up for the week.

What We'll Be Doing:

- Each day will start off with games / other various fun activities.
- And then move into:
 - Art (1 finished art piece each day + mini project)
 - Movement (Dance, silly movement, games/teambuilding)
- LUNCH (please pack)
 - Science (Experiments, Slime & more)
 - Play (Free time play dough, legos, beading and more)

***Each day will be a new and unique theme or topic and we'll be working hard to create an educational and fun experience each day to turn this negative into a positive experience for everyone!

How We're Staying Safe:

- We are being extra vigilant about washing hands WELL and OFTEN.
 - We'll also have a touch-less hand sanitizer station set up in multiple locations
- Modify our classroom setup and procedures to encourage social distancing
 - Tape table to create a personal space
 - Limiting our group size and keeping more distance
 - Limit shared materials
 - i.e. each camper will have their own set of brushes for the week
 - slime materials etc.
 - Staff and campers will wear face coverings
- The studio will be disinfected throughout the day and comprehensively each night.
- Ask parents to take their child's temperature each day before coming to camp, and to stay home and notify us if anyone in their household falls ill.
- ***No outsiders! All open studio and other activities during the week have been suspended. No one else will be in the studio besides our campers.
 - If you're looking for outside activities duronig our camp weeks, well be offering our Virtual Lessons or NEW: Camp Crates (5 Pre-Recorded Lessons, extra activities and more!)
- Modify our drop off and pick up procedures.
 - We ask that all campers come directly to SpatterBox from home each morning and afternoon: call when downstairs - we'll come down for pickup & back down for drop off to eliminate excess people in our space.

Who Is This For:

- Children 5 12
- Parents who *DO NOT* travel in NYC each day (Please & Sorry)
- We are only taking campers on a weekly basis, not by the day.

 Note: this is the policy only now...we will go back to normal when allowed!

We ask that everyone follows the current safety protocols that have been established, including taking temperature before coming and paying close attention to anything out of the norm. Any sneezing, coughing, runny nose - please stay home!

We hope to help families who NEED to work and can't be home - we are not recommending leaving the house by any means but would like to provide a contained, fun experience to help your kiddos continue to learn and have fun with us.
